Registrations open on **31 August 2026** and close on **15 September 2026**. The participation fee for every event in this category is **₹400 per participant, per event**. For team-based events, the total fee is calculated on the number of participants in the team. A school may enter as many events, teams, and participants as it wishes. Payment details are provided on the official website for your convenience.

Every single participant receives a verifiable certificate. Certificates of Participation and winning certificates alike carry a unique QR code and can be verified at any time through our platform, which makes them genuinely useful for LinkedIn profiles, portfolios, and college applications. Winners additionally receive physical certificates, trophies, and medals; cash prizes and goodies are event specific.

Special school offer: schools entering **14 or more events** unlock a **40% discount** on their total participation fee and become eligible for the Rolling Trophy and a special cash prize based on overall performance across the championship.

In addition, participants will receive curated resources and expert feedback from the evaluation panel based on their performance, so that every entry becomes a chance to improve.

Almost every event in this brochure runs in one of two ways: a timed round taken on our own platform and scored automatically, or a submission uploaded through the website before a deadline – nothing to attend, no fixed appearance. The two exceptions are **Vibe Craft** and **Venture Launch**, which are held as private one-to-one online sessions that each team books for itself at a time that suits it. Students take part from school or from home with nothing more than a device and an internet connection. REGISTRATION PHASE

31 August – 15 September 2026

Registrations open on 31 August and close on 15 September. Schools may register any number of participants and teams.

PARTICIPANT ONBOARDING

16 – 20 September 2026

Every registered participant and teacher-in-charge is added to a dedicated email chain. Schedules, instructions, guidelines, booking links, and all further correspondence run through that chain – please whitelist our address.

COMPETITION PHASE

21 – 30 September 2026

All events are conducted online as per their respective schedules across these ten days. Live rounds, submission windows, and demonstration slots are published in advance.

CONCLUSION OF EVENTS

30 September 2026

All competitions conclude and submission portals close. Evaluation by the expert panel begins immediately afterwards.

5

RESULTS & FELICITATION

10 October 2026

Final results are announced and winners are felicitated with certificates, medals, trophies, and prizes. Verifiable certificates go live on the website.

Almost nothing to attend. Timed rounds run on our own platform and are scored automatically, and every other event is a submission uploaded before its deadline. Only **Vibe Craft** and **Venture Launch** involve a live session, and each team books that one-to-one slot itself. No travel, no venue, no lost school days.

- Working need not be submitted unless a question asks for it.
- Any use of a second device will lead to disqualification.
- Tie-breakers will be decided by speed of correct response.

Word Wizard is a live online language round built from vocabulary puzzles, grammar traps, idiom hunts, comprehension snippets, and word play. Questions get harder as the round progresses, and the final section asks teams to rewrite a clumsy sentence into a clean one. Separate question sets are used for junior and senior groups.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 The round is conducted live online through the official platform.
- 2 Participants must log in before the event begins.
- 3 Only registered team members may participate.
- 4 No dictionaries, notes, search engines, or outside help are permitted.
- 5 Participants must ensure a stable internet connection.
- 6 Written answers must be typed into the platform within the timer.
- 7 The organisers' decision will be final.

A social, educational, environmental, inspirational, or thought-provoking topic revealed by the organisers on the official website.

ELIGIBILITY

Grades 8 to 12

MODE OF CONDUCT

Online

TEAMS PER SCHOOL

Any number of participants may participate

PARTICIPANTS

Individual participation

TIME LIMIT

90 minutes for writing, followed by 10 minutes for submission

EVENT FORMAT

The topic for the Essay Writing Competition is revealed on the official website at the start of the event. Once the topic is announced, participants have 90 minutes to write their essay. After the writing time is over, participants are given 10 minutes to submit their final entry through the official website. The essay is judged on thought, structure, and honest expression rather than on length.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 The essay must be written only by the participant.
- 2 The essay must remain directly relevant to the topic revealed by the organisers.
- 3 Participants must maintain a proper structure with introduction, body, and conclusion.
- 4 The work must be original and free from plagiarism.
- 5 Grammar, presentation, coherence, and clarity are important.
- 6 The final submission must be made within the 10-minute submission window.

TIME LIMIT

90 minutes for writing, followed by 10 minutes for submission

EVENT FORMAT

The prompt for the Story Writing Competition is revealed on the official website at the start of the event. Participants then have 90 minutes to write an original story based on the given prompt. After the writing period ends, participants receive 10 minutes to submit their final entry online. Imagination, a clear arc, and characters worth caring about are what carry an entry forward.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 The story must be original and written by the participant only.
- 2 The story must clearly reflect the revealed theme or prompt.
- 3 The narrative should have a proper beginning, middle, and end.
- 4 The story should show creativity, imagination, and meaningful expression.
- 5 Content must be appropriate for school-level participation.
- 6 The final entry must be submitted within the prescribed submission window.
- 7 No copied or pre-written material is allowed.

Both drafts are scored, so a team is judged on how well it builds a case and on how well it argues back against a real opponent.
